Project Description

Thank you for your interest in our Majors at Mason Video Project! Mason is home to eighty-five different bachelor's degree programs, all of which have their own unique opportunities and experiences. These majors are all listed and thoroughly described on Mason's various websites, but this isn't always the most effective way to communicate this information to students with various different learning styles. This is why F1rst Gen Mason has made it our mission to take the next step and host a video series wherein we interview students and faculty within each major to learn more about what each major entails, and to share this information with all George Mason students. The goal of this project is to document information about every single major in order to give students another key resource that will help with their overall success in college.

Your task in this project would be to choose one faculty, advisor, undergraduate student, or graduate student and interview them about their degree program. The questions for this interview are provided in the latter parts of this packet and are categorized based on whom you will be interviewing. This packet was organized by F1rst Gen Mason to help aid you in the process of scheduling and conducting your interview. It contains the interview guidelines, email templates, and interview questions that should be utilized as you set up and proceed with your interview. By following these guidelines, we can ensure that the interview will be both professional and informative. Please look through this process carefully and ensure to follow all steps.

Interview Set-Up Instructions

- 1) Research the interviewee, and find their email address.
- 2) Go the following website and fill out your interview information:

- 3) Copy and paste the Email Template in the next page and edit it in a separate word document. Note: If you wish to use the fill in the blank feature, download the email template document on the F1rst Gen Mason main website (<http://www.f1rstgen.org/Majors-At-Mason>).
- 4) Fill out the template and log into your **Masonlive Email**.
- 5) Copy and paste the **Subject**.
- 6) Copy and paste the template into your email.
- 7) Bcc the following email: hdang8@gmu.edu.
- 8) Look over the email one last time before hitting *Send*.

Interview Guidelines

- 1) Greet the person respectfully.
- 2) Introduce yourself and our organization.
 - a. First Gen Mission:

The mission of F1rst Gen Mason is to create an educational and supportive network that will increase the retention and graduation rate of first-generation students.
 - b. The purpose of the initiative:

To provide First Gen students the first-hand information from the perspective of advisors, undergraduate and graduate students from different majors at Mason.
- 3) Ask for permission to video record, and publish this on our website at f1rstgen.org
- 4) Set up the Tri-pod, and start recording.
 - a. Note: If you choose to use your cellphone to record, please do it in **landscape**.
- 5) Ask them to speak to the camera:
 - a. Name
 - b. Job title / Major
- 6) Questions for...
 - a. Advisors:
 1. What type of students should want to look into the (Name of the major) ?
 2. What is (Name of the major)? In other words, what does it generally focus on?
 3. What are the classes that a student in the major typically needs to take throughout the program?
 4. What are the steps for declaring or switching into the major? What are the required prerequisite classes?
 5. Could you share a few success stories from the students in the major that you know throughout your career at Mason?

b. Graduate Students:

1. Are you currently pursuing a graduate program or working full-time?

Questions for Graduate Students	Questions for Working Students
What are the steps to apply for your graduate program?	What company are you working for?
What was your GPA upon completing your Bachelor's Degree?	Could you share any tips for securing a job after graduation?
Could you share any tips for getting into a Master's program?	How often do you need to apply the knowledge you learned in your undergraduate classes?
Could you share any tips on how to afford graduate school?	Do you think you are financially secure? If yes, can you share a few tips on how to be manage money?
What is your schedule typically like as a graduate student?	What is your schedule typically like as a full-time worker?
Why did you decide to pursue a Master Degree?	Why did you decide to join the workforce after getting your Bachelor's Degree?
Why would a recent graduate want to pursue a Master's Degree?	Why should a recent graduate want to enter the workforce upon completing their Bachelor's Degree?

c. Undergraduate Students:

1. What classes are you taking?
2. What is your most favorite class?
3. What is your least favorite class?
4. How many hours do you typically put into studying?
5. What is the most challenging aspect about your major?
6. What are the skills or knowledge that you have developed to be successful in your major?
7. If you can describe your major in less than 5 words, what would you say?
- 7) Stop the recording and conclude the interview by thanking them for participating.
